

Freescale's MC34844A is a 10-channel LED driver with integrated boost converter for use in LCD backlights. It is designed to provide LED current control and pulse width modulation (PWM) in monitors from 10 to 27 inches, and a more uniform display and improved image quality through highly accurate LED current matching.

With the capability of driving up to 160 LEDs in 10 parallel strings, the device is capable of driving LED backlights up to 30 watts while supporting PWM, I²C or SM bus control. LED current in the 10 LED channels is matched to within ± 2 percent, and the value is set with a resistor from the ISET pin to ground.

Freescale is the first to combine this level of intelligence in an LED backlight driver. Using an I²C/ SM-bus interface, users can program the LED current, amplitude, PWM frequency, PWM duty cycle for the LEDs, boost switching frequency and boost OVP. The PWM generator

allows for LED dimming, providing an improved picture and longer screen life. The device can also deliver more consistent performance over the lifetime of the LEDs by compensating for optical and temperature degradation.

The MC34844A supports optical/temperature closed loop operation and features LED overtemperature protection, LED open circuit

protection, IC overvoltage protection, overcurrent protection and undervoltage lockout. It also provides ambient light compensation for improved battery life in portable devices such as PC notebooks.





The MC34844A removes the burden on the controller for PWM generation and removes the need for having long PCB traces with PWM signals which can cause noise and electromagnetic compatibility performance issues. Multiple devices can be synchronized for driving more LEDs. The MC34844A can also be used in applications using high-voltage LED strings and high-input voltage with the addition of a single external FET.
